Format: Individual or Panel Presentations; Academic Papers, Films, Poetry Readings, Storytelling

Requirements: As appropriate, abstracts are to be no more than 300 words; final papers cannot be more than 10 pages. If you have a panel presentation, please identify all members and affiliations (abstracts are requested from each panel member); **Submit abstracts to jgaskin@iaia.edu by December 1, 2011.**
